The [International Initiative for Impact Evaluation \(3ie\)](http://www.3ieimpact.org) is offering **6 bursaries** for residents from low and middle income countries attending the Campbell Collaboration Colloquium in Copenhagen from May 29-31, 2012. The Colloquium provides two days of training on systematic reviews, including beginner and advanced training streams, one day of panel sessions, and exposure to the community of practice of systematic reviews in international development and the social sciences. The bursary will include workshop fees and economy air travel. Accommodation will also be provided beginning May 29th through the night of May 31st. Any other associated expenses will have to be borne by the participant. **Deadline for bursary applications is 12:00 Noon EST, February 15th 2012.**

Eligibility criteria for bursary

To be eligible, you need to be a national residing in a low or middle income country and be actively engaged in the field of systematic reviews. Preference will be given to those developing protocols for Campbell or Cochrane systematic reviews of international development interventions and to those who have submitted posters for the 2012 Campbell Colloquium.

- (1) A statement of 300 words or less which says whether you are applying as a policy maker or a researcher. The statement should include:
 - a. Any experience in systematic review
 - b. How systematic review is utilized in your current position
 - c. What you would do with the skills acquired in the Colloquium
 - d. Whether you have submitted a poster for the 2012 Campbell Colloquium
- (2) Your CV

Please note that applications received in any other format will not be considered for a bursary. Only selected bursaries will be contacted and notified of the award.
