



**The International Initiative for Impact Evaluation (3ie)** is offering **5 bursaries** for residents from low and middle income countries attending the NONIE 2012 Meeting to be held from 19-20 April 2012 in FAO Headquarters, Rome, Italy. In accordance with NONIE's mandate the meeting will focus on impact evaluation methods and will be a platform for sharing experience on conducting impact evaluation. While not exclusive of other topics, the NONIE 2012 meeting will focus primarily on the following four themes:

- Mixed methods / alternative design approaches / methods for addressing the challenge of attribution;
- Policy use / how impact evaluation influences policy;
- The role of impact evaluation in Monitoring & Evaluation systems; and
- Guidance on and experiences of Impact Evaluation on normative and institutional support work

The meeting is targeted towards evaluation departments of bilateral and UN agencies, researchers and impact evaluation users, managers or practitioners from partner countries. It is open to non-members in order to share different perspectives on and experiences from impact evaluations.

The bursary will include workshop fees and economy air travel. Accommodations will also be provided beginning April 18<sup>th</sup> through the morning of April 21<sup>st</sup>. Any other associated expenses will have to be borne by the participant. **Deadline for bursary applications is 5 p.m. EST, February 17<sup>th</sup> 2012.**

## Eligibility Criteria for Bursary

To be eligible, you need to be a national residing in a low or middle income country and be actively engaged in the field of impact evaluation. Preference will be given to those actively working in the field of impact evaluation and to those presenting at the NONIE 2012 Meeting.
