## Joining 3ie Membership Form

The mission of the International Initiative for Impact Evaluation (3ie) is to improve the lives of poor people in the developing world by providing a stronger evidence base on what works, what does not work, and why. To achieve this mission, 3ie promotes and funds high quality impact evaluations which strive to provide cost effective solutions to critical development problems.

3ie is a membership organization. Members are agencies which finance or implement development programmes, and associate members are agencies undertaking rigorous impact evaluation.

### Criteria for membership

Membership is open to agencies which finance or implement social and economic development programmes in low- and middle-income countries, with an annual expenditure of at least US\$1 million on such programmes, and which are committed to the rigorous evaluation of the programmes they support.



## Membership benefits

- **Commitment to evaluation:** Send signal of commitment to results agenda and use of evidence.
- **Commitment to sharing knowledge:** Agency seen to be supporting the production of knowledge of what works in development and sharing it as a global public good.
- **Steer 3ie:** Through the annual members' conference, members play a key role in determining the strategic direction of 3ie.

- **Priority funding:** Research proposals from members receive an additional 5% score in the review process. If selected, the projects enjoy substantial quality peer advice throughout the project period, as well as support for communications and policy influence.
- **Branding and promotion:** Publications, calls for proposals, job advertisements and impact evaluation related events and projects of members are regularly promoted in 3ie news update, events, website and other 3ie platforms.

## Other services

- **Access to impact evaluation experts screened by 3ie:** 3ie has an online expert roster of leading professionals from around the world with proven experience and who have agreed to feature in this directory to help practitioners and policy makers in designing and conducting impact evaluations of their programmes.

- **Access to 3ie knowledge services:** All 3ie funded studies and data sets will be made available to the public on our web portal once completed. 3ie guidelines and guidance, as well as other training tools and resources will also be regularly uploaded. Members and 3ie subscribers will also receive information on upcoming call for proposals, events, new research and publications.

## Member Obligations

**Contributions:** Fees are minimum member contributions. All members are encouraged to make voluntary contributions.

- **Developing country institutions:** In kind support through assistance in organizing local activities in support of 3ie's mission in liaison with 3ie.
- **Bilateral and multilateral development agencies:** US\$100,000 per annum.
- **Foundations:** US\$100,000 per annum.
- **International NGOs:** US\$10,000 per annum.
- **Consortia:** consortia are either (1) independent national offices of the same organization, or (2) a group of up to three separate NGOs. The rate for a consortium is US\$20,000 per annum. Full member benefits are available to all agencies in the consortium, except that the group has only one vote at the members' conference.
- **Commitment to evaluation:** Members must produce at least one rigorous evaluation of their own development programs each two years.
