

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS
NONIE 2012 MEETING
19-20 April 2012, Rome, Italy

The United Nations Evaluation Group (UNEG) is organizing the NONIE 2012 Meeting to be held from 19-20 April 2012 in FAO Headquarters, Rome, Italy.

In accordance with NONIE's mandate the meeting will focus upon impact evaluation methods, exchange of experience in conducting impact evaluation and is targeted towards evaluation departments of bilateral and UN agencies, researchers and impact evaluation users, managers or practitioners from partner countries. The meeting is open to non-members in order to share different perspectives on and experiences from impact evaluations.

The NONIE 2012 meeting will focus on the following four themes:

- Mixed methods/ alternative design approaches/ methods for addressing the challenge of attribution;
- Policy use/ how IE influences policy;
- The role of IE in M&E systems; and
- Guidance on and experiences of IE on normative and institutional support work.

It is not exclusive of other topics but proposals on the above themes are encouraged. We now invite submissions on these themes.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINE

Each submission must indicate which theme is being targeted and include a title, author(s) name and affiliation, presenter's name, contact details, presenter's bio (no more than 150 words), and list of key words. The abstract should not be more than 1,000 words.

For the meeting, a PowerPoint presentation will be asked.

Abstracts should be sent to contact.nonie2012@gmail.com no later than **17th February 2012**. Notifications of acceptance will be sent by 2nd March 2012.

- Presenters from developing countries should submit their applications for sponsorship along with their abstract submission (see sponsorship application form).
