





DETPA is a contextually relevant, practice-based M&E programme that aims to promote evidence-informed decision-making for sustainable socio-economic development. The programme aims to build a community of professionals equipped with M&E skills, knowledge and tools, which are fit-for-purpose to address local and global development challenges. This is achieved via a combination of theory and practice based approaches aimed at stimulating interactive participation, critical reflection and debate.

Participants can choose between the Fundamentals and Advanced tracks, or an option to attend individual modules. The Fundamentals and the Advanced tracks are presented in parallel over a period of two weeks.

FUNDAMENTALS TRACK

Suitable for policy makers, programme managers, development workers, new entrants to M&E and those who need a refresher course on M&E Fundamentals. The first week of the course provides an introduction to Results Based Management, including modules on Problem Analysis, building a Theory of Change and a Results Framework. The second week focuses on the basics of evaluation, including evaluation types, management and use

ADVANCED TRACK

This track is designed to enhance the knowledge and expertise of experienced evaluators and M&E practitioners. The course explores M&E and development in Africa from a "Made in Africa" perspective and reviews Advanced evaluation methods, including impact evaluation. It examines evaluation methods in complex environments and the importance of contextual relevance in evaluation in Africa.
