2. Key responsibilities

3ie is currently seeking to appoint senior research fellows to support a range of new and ongoing projects. This is an exciting opportunity for experienced researchers to join the 3ie global team on a part-time basis.

These positions offer a chance to make substantive contributions towards achieving 3ie's mission of improving lives and be involved in interesting work, while developing your research portfolio and academic profile.

The senior research fellows will provide intellectual leadership and technical support on projects falling within their areas of expertise, including but not limited to:

- Lead or contribute to the design and execution of new studies (impact evaluations, systematic reviews, evidence gap maps, replications, methodological research and so on);
- Lead or contribute to the design and development of new evidence programmes;
- Develop policies and procedures for advancing 3ie's research transparency and open science agenda;
- Lead or contribute to academic papers for submission in high impact journals; and
- Represent 3ie at external events as appropriate.
