

KEY INTERVENTIONS


- Preparation of State specific operational strategies
- Formation of gender core team
- Sensitization and training all SMMU, DMMU and BMMU staff, CBO staff and CBO leaders and members
- Introduction of gender agenda and pledge in CBOs
- Incorporation of gender in Dasa Sutris and CBO grading
- Formation and training of gender forums at village and block level
- Formation of Gender Justice centers/Community managed Family counseling centers
- Incorporation of gender activities and indicators in the Job description of all mission and CBO staff
- Scanning and revision of existing Guidelines/advisories/circulars/KPIs with gender lens
- Fostering convergence with line departments, police, Judiciary and Civil Society Organisations
